

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## **ITINERARY**

# September 19, Sunday, Day 1: DEPART NEWARK INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT ON OVERNIGHT FLIGHT TO TEL AVIV

Bus transportation will be provided to Newark airport from St. Mary Center (701 Lansdale Avenue, Lansdale). Dinner and breakfast served on the flight.

#### **<sup>+</sup>September 20, Monday, Day 2: ARRIVAL IN TEL AVIV**

Upon arrival, we are greeted by our English-speaking Christian tour guide and assisted with customs and passport control. Board our coach and drive to Jaffa for a short visit and to celebrate Mass. We continue to the Sea of Galilee area where we have a well-deserved night of rest. Dinner and overnight in the Sea of Galilee area. (D)

#### September 21, Tuesday, Day 3: NAZARETH - CANA - MT. TABOR

A short drive takes us to Nazareth, the town of Mary's home, where Jesus played as a child, learned a trade, and grew to manhood. We visit Mary's Well and St. Joseph's Church. Later this morning, we celebrate Mass at the Basilica of the Annunciation. Here St. John Paul II celebrated Mass during his historic visit to the Holy Land in the Great Jubilee Year of Our Lord 2000. We stop at Mt. Precipice, from where we have a magnificent view of the Jezreel Valley. The angry multitudes wanted to throw Jesus from this mountain after His teaching at the Nazareth Synagogue. Next, we visit Mt. Tabor to see The Church of Transfiguration and to enjoy lunch (included) at Mt. Tabor Hospice. Continue to Cana, where couples may choose to renew their wedding vows at the Wedding Church. Our dinner tonight is a buffet at our hotel. Overnight Sea of Galilee area. (B. L. D.)

# September 22, Wednesday, Day 4: THE SEA AND THE SHORES OF THE GALILEE - MAGDALA - CAPERNAUM - TABGHA

Depart for the Sea of Galilee to enjoy a morning boat ride and visit the "Jesus Boat," a vessel dated to the time of Jesus. We visit Magdala, home of St. Mary Magdalene and celebrate Mass at the Mt. of Beatitudes. Taste St. Peter's Fish for lunch at the Pilgerhaus before departing for Capernaum, where Jesus began His Galilean ministry. Here we explore the synagogue which dates to the time of Christ and see the site of St. Peter's home. Visit the church with a glass floor constructed over the site, allowing us to look down into the excavated ruins of Peter's house. Our next stop is to the Church of the Primacy of Peter, situated on the shore of the Sea of Galilee where, after His resurrection, Jesus met with His disciples and told Peter, "feed my lambs; feed my sheep," (John 21:9). Our last stop is the Church of Multiplication of Loaves and Fishes, commemorating where Jesus fed the crowd of 5,000. Tonight, enjoy a special dinner at Magdalena Restaurant near Tiberias. The amazing assortment of local, farm-to-table dishes is accompanied by your choice of beverages including a choice of wine, beer, or soda (up to two glasses per person). Overnight Sea of Galilee area. (B. L. Special dinner).

## September 23, Thursday, Day 5: MT. CARMEL – CAESAREA MARITIMA – BETHLEHEM – SHARING THE BREAD DINNER

Following breakfast, we visit the monastery of Stella Maris atop Mount Carmel to celebrate Mass. We also see Our Lady of Mt. Carmel. Then, it's off to enjoy the sea, ruins, and salty air at Caesarea Maritima, the ancient harbor from which St. Paul set off to spread the Good News! We enjoy lunch on our own at the port of Caesarea Maritima before departing for Bethlehem. Enjoy a Genesis welcome before arriving in Bethlehem and checking into our hotel. Tonight is a very special dining experience as we are invited into the homes of local Christian families to break bread with them and share a fellowship experience. Our group will be split up into smaller groups of 6-8 people and transferred to each family's home to enjoy a home-cooked meal as part of our Sharing the Bread program. Transportation back to the hotel will be provided. Overnight in Bethlehem for three nights. (B. Special dinner)

# September 24, Friday, Day 6: BETHLEHEM – SHEPHERDS' FIELD – CREMISAN WINERY

We begin our day in Bethlehem with a visit to Manger Square and the Church of the Nativity located above the birthplace of Christ. Bending low as we enter through the Door of Humility, we enter the church and descend into the Grotto of Nativity. Beneath the altar, a 14-pointed silver star marks the exact spot surrounded by the Latin inscription: HIC DE VIRGINE MARIA IESUS CHRISTUS NATUS (Here Jesus Christ was born to the Virgin Mary). We celebrate Mass (TBC) and see St. Jerome's Grotto and then the Milk Grotto. We enjoy a visit to the Cremisan Winery run by Salesians, which produces an award-winning wine, named by the Wine Spectator as one of the best wines in Israel. Learn about winemaking in the Holy Land, followed by a wine and cheese reception prepared just for our group. Following a relaxing lunch at Shepherds' Tower, we walk over to Shepherds' Field and Grotto. Tonight, dinner will be at Cheers, a local restaurant. Overnight in Bethlehem. (B. L. Special Dinner)

#### 한September 25, Saturday, Day 7: JERICHO – BAPTISMAL SITE – QUMRAN – DEAD SEA

We visit the Carmelite Monastery to venerate the relics of St. Mariam Baouardy (St. Mariam of Jesus Crucified) - the Lily of Palestine, canonized by Pope Francis in 2015. Here we celebrate Mass. Then depart for Jericho – the first city to be captured by Joshua as part of his conquest of the Land, and the site of the Mount of Temptation. Stop for the Renewal of Baptismal Promises at Qasr Al Yehoud. This site holds the oldest and most ancient tradition for being the place of Jesus' baptism by John the Baptist in the River Jordan (Mathew, 3: 13-17). We break for lunch at the Green Valley Restaurant and time permitting, we stop in Qumran to see where the shepherds found dead Sea Scrolls. Later, drive to the Dead Sea and take a dip in the salty waters and shop for Dead Sea products. Be sure to bring your bathing suit! Dinner and overnight in Bethlehem. (B. L. D.)

#### **<sup>1</sup>September 26, Sunday, Day 8: BETHANY - WAILING WALL**

This morning, we check out of the hotel following breakfast. Our first visit is to a Christian store for shopping. The Kando family is related to the story of the Dead Sea Scrolls, and we have an opportunity to see the actual Dead Sea Scrolls Jar. Our next stop is to take pictures and pray at the Separation Wall just as Pope Francis did during his visit to Bethlehem. Continue to Bethany to see the home of Mary, Martha, and Lazarus and celebrate Mass. We drive to Jerusalem, enjoy lunch at Ramat Rachel and tuck a prayer into the Wailing Wall. Settle into our hotel and enjoy some time at leisure before dinner. Overnight in Jerusalem. (B. L. D.)

#### **<sup>1</sup>**September 27, Monday, Day 9: MT. OF OLIVES - MT. ZION - UPPER ROOM

Following breakfast, we continue to the Mt. of Olives to visit the Ascension Chapel and the Church of Pater Noster, where Jesus taught the Lord's Prayer. Marvel at the panoramic view-appreciating the eternal golden city of Jerusalem. Next, we walk along Palm Sunday Road, stopping at Dominus Flevit, where Jesus wept over the city. Continue along the Jewish cemetery with a view over the Eastern Gate. Then spend quiet time in the Garden of Gethsemane also known as the Garden of Betrayal, where, since the fourth century, tradition has placed the betrayal by Judas. We walk over to the Basilica of Agony, also known as the Church of All Nations, where we celebrate Mass. Following lunch at Yerevan Restaurant, we visit Caiaphas Palace and the Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu. Our final stops of the day are Dormition Abbey and the Upper Room. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Jerusalem. (B. L. D.)

# September 28, Tuesday, Day 10: VIA DOLOROSA - HOLY SEPULCHER - ST. ANNE - EIN KAREM

Start the day early by praying the Stations of the Cross along the Way of the Cross (Via Dolorosa). We are blessed to be able to celebrate Mass this morning at the Church of the Holy Sepulcher, the site where Jesus was crucified buried, and rose. We return to the hotel for breakfast and rest. Our day continues with visits to St. Anne's Church and to see the Pools of Bethesda, where Jesus healed the Paralytic. Proceed to Ein Karem to visit the Church of the Visitation, see Mary's Spring, and the birthplace of John the Baptist. Enjoy a farewell dinner at Az-Zahra Restaurant. Overnight in Jerusalem. (B. Special Dinner.)

#### September 29, Wednesday, Day 11: Arrive in the USA

We depart for the airport following breakfast to catch our flight back home. Bus transportation included from Newark airport to St. Mary Center (701 Lansdale Avenue, Lansdale).

#### **OPTIONAL JORDAN EXTENSION**

#### TSeptember 29, Wednesday, Day 11: ALLENBY – MADABA – MT NEBO – PETRA

Following breakfast, we depart for Allenby Bridge Crossing where we say farewell to our Israeli guide and driver and meet our Jordanian guide and driver. We cross the border in Jordan carrying our own suitcases and board the bus which takes us to Madaba, where we visit St. George's Church to see the mosaic floor map of the Holy Land. Lunch is included today, and after lunch we continue to Mt. Nebo, which according to ancient tradition is the mountain from which Moses saw the Promised Land before he died. We celebrate Mass before continuing to the Dead Sea, where we check in to our hotel for dinner and an overnight. (B. L. D.)

#### September 30, Thursday, Day 12: PETRA - AMMAN

After breakfast, we drive to Petra, the "rose-red city half as old as time," where we see the Dam, the Siq, the magnificent facade, the Treasury, and many other Nabataean archeological remains, all carved in the stable rock formations. Lunch is included. Mass will be an open-air celebration. We return to our hotel in Petra for dinner and overnight. (B. L. D.)

#### **むOctober 1, Friday, Day 13: JERASH – AMMAN**

Following breakfast, we tour the ancient ruins of Jerash before driving to Amman for an afternoon visit of the city. Our farewell dinner is in a local restaurant. Overnight in Amman. (B. L. Special dinner)

## Important information regarding your trip:

#### Group Air:

Select International Tours is a tour company that specializes in group travel. A group is ten or more people traveling together. For each group we negotiate and secure group air contracts with all major airlines departing from the designated airport. This enables us to keep all passengers within a group traveling together, in most cases utilizing best air rates.

Group air contracts differ from individually purchased airline tickets in many ways. When group air contracts are negotiated, we deposit a certain number of seats to hold the space and GTD the rate. Unused seats must be released at least 90 days prior to departure to avoid a \$ 100.00 per unused seat penalty.

It is important to receive your registration by the deadline stated on the flyer. Once the seats are released back to the airlines, we may be able to accommodate passengers at a different air rate or on a different airline.

Group air contracts limit types of deviations allowed and in some cases issuing tickets at individual rates may be necessary. Individual rates & reservations are not GTD until the tickets are issued. In order to issue an individual ticket we must receive full payment. Taxes and fuel costs are subject to change until the tickets are issued.

#### **Domestic add-on tickets:**

We can assist you with domestic air to connect with our international group air if you wish. Indicate on the registration form which airport you wish us to research air from. We are not responsible for fees or charges incurred in case dates change or the trip is cancelled. However, when buying a domestic add-on ticket through Select we may be able to assist in case of changes.

We will provide you with best schedule to connect with the flight (we are not able to help you with tickets that do not connect directly to the international flight) and the best price we can offer. Our information will be sent to you by e-mail. We require an acceptance within 24 hours of our offer along with full payment otherwise the rate is subject to change based on availability. We cannot quote any domestic air requests more than twice.

#### **Business Class and Economy Plus Seats:**

We are happy to assist you with business class and economy plus seats. Passengers must be registered on one of our trips to receive a quote. We will quote the available rate which is subject to change until we receive payment to purchase the seats. Usually Economy Plus Seats require the group tickets to be issued before the ability to upgrade.

#### Passport and Visa information:

All airlines require us to submit valid passport information including full name (first, middle and last), date of birth, gender, country, in which your passport has been issued and passport expiration date. To ensure that we can provide this information accurately, we require a photo copy of each person's passport traveling on each tour. Your passport must be valid 6 months from the trip return date. It is the passenger's responsibility to check if visas are required for the destinations visited and to obtain any necessary travel documents. Select International Tours does not provide information or assistance about passports or visa requirements.

#### **Frequent Flyer Numbers:**

Select International cannot assist if you wish to reserve air using FF miles. We can update your record with Frequent Flyer #'s only if you note the number on the registration form. Otherwise please call the airline directly.

#### **Seat Requests & Seat Changes**

Select International Tours DOES NOT provide assistance with passenger's seating

preferences or specific seat requests. Due to the large number of passengers we work with, we are unable to provide this service unless the request is due to a medical issue. In this case, we will request a seat with the airline but cannot guarantee that the seat will be confirmed. Please understand that although requests are being made directly with the airline, not every request is guaranteed or granted by the airline. If you would like to have a seat number assigned, it is best to contact the airline directly upon receipt of your ticket confirmation # or change your seats at the time of check-in at the airport prior to departure.

#### "Land Only" (not purchasing group air with Select International Tour Package:

We understand that some passengers may wish to purchase their own air transportation. Arranging transportation on your own may give you the ability to use flight miles for your ticket, secure the seat you desire/require, or deviate from the group. We offer land only prices on all our tours.

Airport transfers are not provided for passengers purchasing land only (not purchasing air with us) if arriving or departing at any time different from the group. If you wish to enjoy the benefit of the group transfer, please be sure you are at the airport at the same time as the group. On certain itineraries airport transfers, may be very costly as the group may be traveling a far distance from the airport on the first or last day.

If the flight schedule you purchase arrives or departs at a time different from the group, it is your responsibility to join the group either at the airport or at the first hotel.

If you register for the air and land package and convert to land only, a \$ 100.00 service charge will be assessed should the change be made within 90 days of departure.

#### Flight cancellations or delays:

In case your flight is cancelled or delayed please work with the airline directly at the airport to be rebooked on the first available flight out. Once you know your new flight and time of arrival contact the emergency number provided in your travel documents to notify your guide of the delay. Your travel documents will contain an emergency number and the guide's phone. Any incurred costs are out of pocket and not included in the trip cost. The cost of private transfers in case of delays are not covered as part of your trip cost. You may file a claim with your Travel Protection Insurance company or with the airlines upon your return. Receipts will be required.

#### Single rooms:

A limited number of single rooms are available on each trip. If you wish to share a room let us know at the time of registration. We will attempt to connect you with another person looking to share. The cost of Travel Protection insurance will be adjusted to reflect the single supplement as insurance cost depends on total trip cost. Should we not be able to accommodate all single room requests and you are not able or willing to share, a complete refund will be provided.

If your roommate cancels, and the room is converted into single usage, a single supplement will be charged.

#### How much walking will there be on this trip?

This active program covers a good amount of ground each day. The days are busy, usually starting with a wake -up call around 7AM and departure by 9AM or earlier. We aim to be back at the hotel between 5PM and 6PM. Times may vary depending on destination and program.

Expect from three to four hours walking on some touring days. The pace is moderate, however you will encounter some uneven surfaces, stairs, steps, cobblestones, and significant slopes. Some tours require walking in the open air with no shade and no seating available.

#### Purchase Up to Final Trip Payment for Pre-Existing Condition Waiver!
