ITINERARY (B-BREAKFAST, L-LUNCH, D-DINNER)

Day 1, Wednesday, July 20: Depart USA for Scotland


We set out for our adventure in Scotland on an overnight flight to Edinburgh. (Dinner and breakfast are served on the flight.)

ITINERARY

Day 2, Thursday, July 21:

St. Andrews, St. Machar's Cathedral, Perth

Our trip leaders Daniel and Haley Stewart & chaplain Fr. Ryan Higdon meet us at Edinburgh airport. We will then travel north to St. Andrews where the remains of apostle Andrew—patron saint of Scotland—are believed to be buried. The cathedral is the largest in Scotland although only the ruins remain. We'll see the nearby castle and celebrate Mass at St. Machar's Cathedral, where legend tells us the arm of William Wallace is buried in the walls. Dinner and overnight in Perth. (L.D.)



Day 3, Friday, July 22:

Balmoral Castle, Braemar Castle, Blair Athol Distillery

We visit Balmoral Castle, the Scottish holiday home to the royal family and the nearby Braemar Castle*, historic home of the Catholic Farquharson Clan. We tour Blair Athol Distillery, founded in 1798. Return to Perth for dinner and overnight. Mass will be celebrated. (B.D.) *Note Braemar castle is accessed via a steep stone staircase, so not accessible for anyone with severe mobility issues.

Day 4, Saturday, July 23:

Pluscarden Abbey, Glenlivet, Glenfiddich Distillery, Aberdeen.

We visit Pluscarden Abbey, a Catholic Benedictine monastery situated in the glen of the Black Burn. Founded in 1230 by Alexander II for the Valliscaulian Order, in 1454 it became a Benedictine house. Mass will be celebrated. We will stop at the site of the Battle of Glenlivet fought on October 3, 1594 where the Catholics won a decisive victory. We finish our day with a tour of one of Scotland's oldest family-owned whisky distilleries, Glenfiddich. Dinner and overnight in Aberdeen. (B.D.)

ITINERARY



Day 5, Sunday, July 24: Loch Ness, Culloden, Inverness

We set out for the Highlands to see wooded lochs and tucked-away villages as we drive toward Loch Ness for a boat ride (and monster-sighting opportunity!). Explore the historic Culloden battlefield where Bonnie Prince Charlie's Jacobite forces were defeated in 1746. We end the day in the Inverness area with an opportunity for pub hopping to hear great local music. Mass will be celebrated. Dinner is at leisure. (B.)

Day 6, Monday, July 25:

Stirling Castle, National Wallace Memorial, Bannockburn

We approach Stirling Castle, home of the Stewart Kings and Queens including Mary Queen of Scots. We tour the castle and see to the north the 220-foot high tower of the National Wallace Monument, commemorating Scotland's great hero William Wallace. To the south are the battlefields of Bannockburn, where Robert the Bruce led his armies to victory over Edward II and his men. We visit the Bannockburn Visitor Center to learn about the famous battle. Mass will be celebrated. Overnight in the area. (B.D.)

Day 7, Tuesday, July 26:


Island of Islay

Today we celebrate Mass before departing for the west coast of Scotland via Kilmartin Glen, where we catch a ferry from Kennacraig to Port Allen on the island of Islay. Our first stop will be one of the legendary distilleries on Islay. We settle into our hotel and enjoy watching a sunset from an Islay beach while sipping whisky accompanied by shortbread and chocolate. Dinner and overnight on Islay. (B.D.)

ITINERARY

Day 8, Wednesday, July 27: Island of Islay, Laphroig Distillery,

Ardbeg Distillery, Kildaton Cross Islay, Finlaggen Islay is the home of one of Scotland's distinctive whisky types - peaty, smoky-flavored single malts. We may get a chance to dig peat, learn about whisky making or have our own privately labeled bottling. Our full-day tour of Islay includes a visit to two whisky distilleries, Laphroaig and Ardbeg. A visit to the Kildalton Cross transports us back in time more than 1200 years and we discover the ancient seat of the Lords of the Isles at Finlaggan. Wildlife abounds on Islay, so keep your eyes open for golden eagles, seals, otters, whales, dolphins, wild geese, red deer, and much more. Discover traditional villages clinging to the rough Atlantic coastline, ruined castles, golden beaches, and a proud Gaelic culture as we explore the most amazing of Hebridean Islands. Lunch is at a restaurant featuring locally sourced products. This evening at the hotel enjoy a whisky tasting master class, sampling a number of the best known brands and comparing whiskies produced in different parts of the country. Mass will be celebrated. Overnight in Islay (B.L.D.)



Day 9, Thursday, July 28: Edinburgh

Today we take the ferry back to the mainland and drive to Edinburgh where we settle into our hotel and have an afternoon and evening at leisure to explore the beautiful city on our own. Mass will be celebrated. Overnight in Edinburgh. (B.)

Day 10, Friday, July 29:

St. Mary's Cathedral, Edinburgh Castle,

St. Margaret's Chapel, Glenkinchie Distillery

Today we celebrate Mass at St Mary's Catholic Cathedral and visit Edinburgh Castle, towering over the Royal Mile. Our visit includes St Margaret's Chapel, the oldest building in the city. We end our time in Scotland with a visit to a whisky distillery. Glenkinchie, the Lowland Home of Johnnie Walker, distills the Edinburgh malt enjoyed worldwide. Tonight we have a farewell dinner at the Sheep Heid Inn, a historic pub that was a favorite of past monarchs and poets. Overnight in Edinburgh. (B. Special dinner)

July 30, Saturday, Day 11: Depart for USA.

Following breakfast, we transfer to Edinburgh airport for our return flight back home. (B.)*

Your passport must be valid through January 30, 2023. Reservations will not be processed until we have passport copies. Prices quoted are based on cash payments. Cash prices \$5,495.00 for the complete package; \$4,595.00 land only (air not included); \$895.00 single supplement (in room by yourself). For credit card payments add 4%.

<u>Pilgrimage prices</u>: Prices are based on minimum 20 passengers. Prices may be adjusted in the event of fewer than 20 passengers, changes in currency conversion rates, or amendments in local government taxes and/or fuel surcharges. Prices are in US dollars.

<u>Solo Travel:</u> A limited number of single rooms are available. Prices are based on two people per room. We do not guarantee roommates but will do our best to connect you with a someone willing to share.

<u>Land Only Option</u>: Land only services start and end at the hotels and do not include any airfare. You are welcome to transfer from the airport with the group if you arrive at the same time, otherwise, transfers are not included.

Tour Cancellation Policy: Individual deposits are refundable except for a \$500.00 per person handling fee for cancellations made 90 days or more before departure. A \$750.00 non-refundable fee will be assessed if the reservation is canceled between 90 and 60 days prior to departure. Withain 60 days of departure all payments are non-refundable regardless of reason for cancellations. All airline tickets are non-refundable once issued. All cancellations must be in writing. Unused portions of the trip are not refundable. If a roommate cancels, the cost of a solo supplement will be added to your invoice. You may be eligible for a refund through your travel protection. Refer to the U.S. Policy by State on our website.

<u>Trip Cancellation Protection</u>: We strongly encourage you to purchase a <u>Travel Protection Plan</u>, for the protection of your travel investment. <u>Airline, seating and special requests:</u> To best accommodate our pilgrims, we often utilize Group Air Reservations. These allow more predictable transfer and tour schedules. However, when booking Group Air, the airline (not Select International Tours) controls seating assignments. If you require very specific seats, we suggest that you book your own airfare and take advantage of our "Land Only" options. You may communicate directly with the air-

line to request seating changes, provide mileage program information, or change passenger contact information once you receive ticket numbers—approximately three (3) weeks prior to departure. We work with instant purchase airline tickets and or group rates. If you switch from air and land to land only within 90 days from departure you will be charged a \$100 service fee in addition to any airline charges. All special needs and requests due to medical or dietary restrictions must be requested in writing at least 60 days prior to departure. Business class and Premium Coach seats are available upon written request; as are add-ons from your hometown airport. If you require very specific airlines or schedules, we suggest that you book your own airfare and take advantage of our "Land Only" options.

Walking: Our trips require daily walking, sometimes up or down slopes, steps, and uneven terrain. We recommend preparing oneself, by walking before the trip. Anyone needing assistance is required to be accompanied by a qualified and physically-able travel companion. We are not responsible for any medical condition that occurs prior, during or after the trip.
