#### **December 12**, Monday, Day 1: DEPART USA

We depart on an overnight flight from New Orleans or DFW to Tel Aviv. Breakfast and dinner will be served on the plane.

#### December 13, Tuesday, Day 2: ARRIVAL - SEA OF GALILEE

Upon arrival at Tel Aviv Airport, we collect our luggage and clear customs before we meet our English-speaking Christian guide outside the customs area. We drive to Tiberias and settle into our hotel on the Sea of Galilee to unpack before dinner at the hotel. Mass will be celebrated. Overnight Sea of Galilee. (D)

#### December 14, Wednesday, Day 3: NAZARETH - CANA - MAGDALA

Following an open buffet breakfast, we drive to Mt. Precipice and enjoy a remarkable view of the Jezreel Valley. We celebrate Mass at the Church of Annunciation and tour the church and the nearby St. Joseph's Church. Following lunch, we depart for Cana of Galilee, where the couples in the group have the opportunity to renew their wedding vows. Following the Vow renewal, we visit the Valley of the Doves and Magdala before returning to our hotel to relax and freshen up for our dinner at Magdalena Restaurant. Overnight Sea of Galilee.

(B. Special dinner)

#### December 15, Thursday Friday, Day 4: SEA OF GALILEE

After breakfast, we start our day with a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee and see the boat from the time of Jesus, known as the "Jesus Boat." Visit Mt. of Beatitudes, where we celebrate Mass and have time for prayer and reflection. Following lunch, we visit Caesarea Phillipi and Capernaum to see Peter's House. Special dinner at Decks restaurant or similar. Overnight Sea of Galilee. (B, L, Special dinner)

#### December 16, Friday Saturday, Day 5: MT. TABOR - SHARING THE BREAD

This morning we drive to Tabgha to see the Church of the Multiplication of Fish and Loaves and The Church of Peter's Primacy on the Sea of Galilee. We depart for Mt. Tabor to visit the Church of the Transfiguration, where we celebrate Mass. Following lunch, at Mt. Tabor, we depart for Bethlehem, traveling through the Jordan Valley, and settle into the hotel. Tonight is our special "Sharing the Bread" dinner with Christian Families of Bethlehem in their homes. Overnight in Bethlehem. (B, L, Special Dinner)

#### **<sup>1</sup>December 17, Saturday, Day 6: BETHLEHEM**

Following breakfast, we visit Shepherd's Field and the Church of the Nativity. We celebrate Mass (TBC) next door in the Church of St. Catherine's. Following Mass, we have time to shop for mementos of our pilgrimage at the Kando store, a Christian cooperative that helps support dozens of Christian families from this area. Overnight in Bethlehem. (B, L, D)

#### December 18, Sunday, Day 7: MT. OF OLIVES - MT. ZION

We depart for Jerusalem and start the morning with Mass at the Basilica of Agony. Our visit continues with Mt. of Olives, where we see the Ascension Chapel and Pater Noster, enjoy a magnificent view of the city of Jerusalem, and walk down Palm Sunday Road. We stop to see Dominus Flevit along the way, where Jesus wept over Jerusalem, and end our walk in the Garden of Gethsemane. Following lunch on our own, we visit Mt. Zion to see St. Peter in Gallicantu, Dormition Abbey, Upper Room, and King David's Tomb. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Jerusalem (B, D)

#### 廿December 19, Monday Day 8: DEAD SEA – BAPTISMAL SITE ON THE RIVER JORDAN

Following breakfast, we visit Jericho, the oldest continuously inhabited city in the world where we celebrate Mass. We stop for lunch at Limonah and to see the Sycamore Tree, Tel Jericho, and the Mt. of Temptation. We visit the Baptismal Site on the River Jordan and drive through the Judean Hills to take a dip in the Dead Sea. (don't forget to pack a bathing suit) Overnight in Jerusalem. (B, L, D)

#### **<sup>1</sup>December 20, Tuesday, Day 9: HOLY CITY OF JERUSALEM**

This morning we are up early to walk the peaceful streets of the Holy City of Jerusalem,

He has been to the Holy Land twice before and enjoys traveling, preaching, and watching movies.

Fr. Carl Paustian, O.P. is a Dominican Friar of the Province of St. Martin de Porres. He was ordained to the priesthood in 2018 and has spent his first three years of ministry at St. Elizabeth's University Parish in Lubbock, Texas, as the Chaplain to Raider Catholic Campus Ministry at Texas Tech University. In July 2021, Fr. Carl moved to New Orleans to serve as the Director of Vocations for the Dominican Friars. Originally from Houston, Fr. Carl is a graduate of Texas A&M University. He is excited to travel to the Holy Land and to walk in the footsteps of Jesus and his disciples.

praying the Stations of the Cross along the Via Dolorosa to the Church of the Holy Sepulcher where we celebrate Holy Mass. (TBC) We return to our hotel for breakfast and some rest before embarking on a city tour including a visit to St. Anne's Church and the Pool of Bethesda, Ecce Homo, Judgement Hall, and the Chapel of Flagellation. After lunch on our own, we visit the Wailing Wall to tuck a prayer into the wall crevice as Pope John Paul II, Pope Benedict, and Pope Francis have done before us. Tonight we enjoy a special dinner at the rooftop Wine and Cheese bar, overlooking the beautiful Old City of Jerusalem. Overnight in Jerusalem. (B, Special dinner)

#### 了December 21, Wednesday, Day 10: EIN KAREM – BETHANY – EMMAUS

This morning we depart for Bethany to see the home of Lazarus, Mary, and Martha and where Jesus raised Lazarus from the dead. Our next stop is the Church of Visitation at Ein Karem, where we visit the birthplace of St John the Baptist and celebrate Mass. We continue to Emmaus, where Jesus appeared to the two disciples after the Resurrection (Lk 24:13-35). We end our pilgrimage in the biblical town of Joppa known today as Jaffa. Peter came to Joppa from Lydda to raise Tabitha (Dorcas) from the dead (Acts 9:36-42). While in Joppa, the apostle stayed at the house of Simon the Tanner. When Peter was praying on the roof, he had a vision of a large sheet filled with animals being lowered from heaven (Acts 9:43–10:23), signaling to him to go with the messengers from Cornelius, a centurion in the Roman army. The Church of St. Peter marks the traditional site of Peter's vision of the great sheet. Following our Farewell Dinner, we depart for the airport for our overnight flight home after an unforgettable pilgrimage. (B, Farewell Dinner)
