

DAILY ITINERARY

☆April 22, Saturday, DAY 1: DEPART U.S.A.

We depart on an overnight flight to Lisbon, Portugal. Dinner and breakfast will be served on the plane. Add-on airfares are available from most major cities.

₩April 23, Sunday, DAY 2: WELCOME TO PORTUGAL

We arrive in the capital city of Lisbon and are met by our Portuguese English-speaking guide who will assist us to the coach. This afternoon we enjoy a panoramic tour of Lisbon, which includes St. Jerome's Monastery, built to give thanks to the Blessed Mother, the Belem Tower, the Navigation Monument, and many other landmarks. Our last stop will be St. Anthony's Church. This patron saint of lost things is best known as St. Anthony of Padua (Italy), but he was born and baptized here in Lisbon, Portugal. The Church where we celebrate Mass is built upon St. Anthony's birthplace. Welcome dinner and overnight in Lisbon. (D)

☆April 24, Monday, DAY 3: SANTAREM – FATIMA

Departing Lisbon we drive to the Church of the Holy Miracle (formerly known as the Church of St. Stephen) in Santarem to venerate the 13th century Miracle of the Eucharist and celebrate Mass. In the afternoon we arrive in Fatima, settle into our hotel, and walk across the street to visit the Shrine of Our Lady of Fatima. Dinner at the hotel in Fatima. (B.D.)

☆April 25, Tuesday, DAY 4: OUR LADY OF FATIMA

Today will surely be a memorable experience, as we explore one of Our Blessed Mother's most important apparition sites. Our Lady appeared to three shepherd children; Lucia (age 10), Jacinta (age 7), and Francisco (age 9). These apparitions occurred monthly from May until October of 1917. Historically, as the entire world was in true turmoil, Our Lady's

most prominent message during this time was to pray for world peace. Our first stop is the Little Chapel of the Apparitions. This simple, yet modern chapel is the site where the Virgin Mary first appeared on May 13, 1917. Continue with a visit to the stunning neoclassical church, the Basilica of Our Lady of the Rosary, which contains the tombs of St. Francisco, St. Jacinta, and Sister Lucia. View the monument that commemorates the Sacred Heart of Jesus, in the square. Due to Our Lady's consistency in her messages to pray the Rosary, this Basilica also features fifteen altars, dedicated to the fifteen mysteries of the Rosary. Visit the Museum with the exhibition: Fatima- Light and Peace. Continue with a visit to the Holy Trinity Basilica. After lunch, we pray at the Stations of the Cross along the Via Sacra. The "Sacred Way" marks the path taken by the shepherd children of Fatima to their first apparition with Our Lady. It is composed of fifteen small chapels in commemoration of the Passion of Our Lord. The day ends with a visit to Valinhos, the site of Our Lady's August 1917 apparition, and the first and third apparition of the Angel. Mass will be celebrated. Our night will conclude with private devotions, and a candlelight procession, requested by Our Lady (1917). Enjoy dinner and a comfortable night's rest in Fatima. (B.L.D.)

☆April 26, Wednesday, DAY 5: FATIMA - AVEIRO - PORTO CRUISE EMBARKATION

Following Mass and time for shopping in Fatima we drive to Aveiro, called Venice of Portugal where we have time to stroll the streets along the meandering canals and have lunch. Arriving in Porto, the capital of the wine-making region of Portugal known for its port wine, we embark on our ship the MS Gil Eanes, our home for the next seven nights. Settle into our comfortable cabins before we meet for orientation and welcome cocktails in the lounge. Dinner and overnight on the ship. (B.D.)

다April 27- Thursday, DAY 6: PORTO – AFTERNOON RETREAT ON THE SHIP

Porto, built on staggered hills along the river, invites you to stroll through its labyrinthine streets and stairways, medieval alleys, Baroque churches, fountains, and bell towers, Beaux-Arts buildings, and bohemian neighborhoods. Our walking tour includes the town's historic center and the Ribeira, the riverfront district. It's hard to take a bad picture in Porto, where houses are clad in painted tiles and fascinating, eclectic architecture awaits us around every corner. Since the 18th century, when Portuguese vintners created a sweet fortified wine - now famous as port that could make the long sea voyage to Britain without spoiling, the Douro Valley has been the only supplier of port to the world, and the oldest demarcated wine region. We visit a local port-making facility before returning to the ship for lunch and an afternoon retreat with our group leaders. Mass will be celebrated. Dinner and overnight on the ship. (B.L.D.)

다April 28, Friday, DAY 7: PORTO – BRAGA – BOM JESUS – PESO da REGUA

We disembark from the ship to make our way by bus to the city of Braga, where we celebrate Mass at the spectacular Sanctuary of Our Lady of Sameiro (Santuario de Nossa Senhora do Sameiro), the country's second-largest shrine dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary. Our visit continues with the exploration of the Shrine of Good Jesus of the Mountain (Santuário Bom Jesús do Monte), a magnificent hilltop shrine surrounded by a lush forest. We explore the grounds, perhaps walking all the way up the Baroque double stairway to the top (381 feet) or taking the funicular which dates back to the end of the 19th century. Lunch is included today in Bom Jesus. Return to the ship in Peso da Regua for dinner and overnight. (B.L.D.)

PApril 29- Saturday, DAY 8: PESO DE REGUA - AFTERNOON SAILING - VEGA DE TERRON

We disembark in the historic town of Peso da Régua, once a busy hub where wooden boats called rabelos, laden with barrels of port, sailed downriver to Vila Nova de Gaia. We celebrate Mass in the local church and visit Casa Mateus. We travel by motorcoach to the idyllic, tranquil village of Pinhão where we reboard the ship for lunch. The Douro River Valley and its unique landscapes of terraced mountains, villages, and wine estates unfold this afternoon as we sail towards the Spanish port town of Vega de Terron, where the Douro forms the border between Spain and Portugal. Tonight we enjoy a Flamenco show in the lounge. (B.L.D.)

다April 30, Sunday, DAY 9: SALAMANCA

Today we journey to Salamanca, Spain's oldest college town. We quickly forget about the lengthy border-crossing ride when we arrive in La Dorada (The Golden City), which gets its nickname from the beautiful glow of the sandstone structures. Europe's oldest (and possibly one of the most beautiful) universities, dating back to 1134, sits in the heart of Salamanca, along with the city's main square (Plaza Mayor), two cathedrals, the House of Shells, and a multitude of medieval, Gothic, and Baroque buildings. Despite the seemingly large size of the city, it feels like a small Spanish village. We celebrate Mass at the magnificent cathedral. During our visit, don't miss the opportunity to sample freshly made churros served with thick hot chocolate at Valor! Lunch is on our own today. We return to the ship for dinner and overnight. (B.D.)

「May 1- Monday, DAY 10: QUINTAS WINE REGION - FERRADOSA - PINHAO

After lunch and our morning spent sailing through the Quintas wine region we disembark in Ferradosa and visit the Quinta do Seixo estate. located just outside of Pinhão. This 100acre estate is one of the most traditional and renowned wine producers in the region. The views from their terrace of the valley below will leave you speechless! We continue to Pinhao and see its early-20th-century train station, adorned with blue-painted tiles (azulejos), and explore the village which sits along a scenic bend in the Douro River and serves as the epicenter of the valley's port winemaking region. Pinhão is known as the gateway to the valley's Quintas (vineyards) and large wine estates. We celebrate Mass before we board the ship in Pinhao for dinner and overnight. (B.L.D.)

This morning we drive to the picturesque Lamego, home to one of the most important pilgrimage sites in Portugal, the Nossa Senhora dos Remédios (Sanctuary of Our Lady of Remedies). There are more than 600 steps to ascend to the top – but fortunately, we are starting at the top and walking down! It is still a very memorable experience. To think that the

pilgrims who visit here actually go up on their knees... See Lamego's Sé and explore the lovely town before returning to the ship in Regua for lunch. Mass will be celebrated. We sail in the afternoon on the ship cruising towards Porto. Tonight we enjoy the Captain's dinner and local entertainment. Overnight on the ship. (B.L.D.)

May 3, Wednesday, DAY 12: DISEMBARKATION IN PORTO

This morning we disembark in Porto and are transferred to the airport for our flight home. (B.)

Optional extension to Santiago de Compostela

TMay 3, Wednesday, DAY 12: SPANISH FOOD AND WINE - PONTEVEDRA - SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA

We disembark from our ship in Porto and drive across the border from Portugal to Spain to Pontevedra, the largest Marian shrine in the country, where we celebrate Mass. We learned about Portuguese wines during our cruise but today we have a taste of Spanish food and wine. In Combados we visit a Spanish winery and enjoy tasting Albarino wine with lunch. We arrive at 0 Grove for a boat ride along the Ria de Arousa to learn about the mussels production which this area is known for. Our final stop for the day is the famous city of Santiago, where all pilgrimage roads lead. Dinner and overnight in Santiago. (B.Special lunch. D.)

다 May 4, Thursday, DAY 13: WALKING THE CAMINO – SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA

This morning choose to join pilgrims from all over the world in walking the last few miles of the El Camino (11 km approximately, 2-3 hours walking time) or you may choose to visit a local monastery garden that this area is famous for. Both groups will congregate at the Monte del Gozo from which the spires of the magnificent Cathedral of St. James are visible. Formed by Galician granite, this cathedral is one of the finest architectural examples in Europe as it encompasses Romanesque, Gothic, and Baroque styles. The cathedral* contains numerous, valuable pieces of art that truly captivate the eye. It is traditional to hug the statue of St. James upon entering the cathedral. Our private guided walking tour takes us into the crypt where the relics of the patron saint of pilgrims' are kept. We celebrate Mass before our farewell dinner tonight at the Catholic Pilgrimage House across the street from the cathedral. Overnight in Santiago. (B. Special dinner) *Cathedral of St. James is under renovation and some portions may not be accessible.

TMay 5, Friday, DAY 14:RETURN TO USA

After breakfast, we are transferred to the airport for our flight home. (B.)



Deposits and Final Payment: A deposit of \$750.00 per person by check should accompany the registration form along with your optional travel protection payment, and a copy of your passport picture page by January 3, 2023. Final payment is due by January 22, 2023. A late payment fee of \$100 will be charged per person for all payments received after the final payment date. <u>Solo Travel:</u> A limited number of single rooms are available. Prices are based on two people per room. We do not guarantee room mates but will do our best to connect you with a possible share.

<u>Land Only Option:</u> Land only services start and end at the hotels, unless you are able to meet the group at the airport, and do not include airfare.

Airline Seating and Special Requests: To best accommodate our pilgrims,

we often utilize Group Air Reservations. These allow more predictable transfer and tour schedules. However, when booking Group Air, the airline (not Select International Tours) controls seating assignments. If you require very specific seats, we suggest that you book your own airfare and take advantage of our "Land Only" options. You may communicate directly with the airline to request seating changes, provide mileage program information, or change passenger contact information once you receive ticket numbers—approximately three (3) weeks prior to departure. We work with instant purchase airline tickets and or group rates. If you switch from air and land to land only within 90 days from departure you will be charged a \$100 service fee in addition to any airline charges. All special needs and requests due to medical or dietary restrictions must be requested in writing at least 60 days prior to departure. Business class and Premium Coach seats are available upon written request; as are add-ons from your hometown airport. If you require very specific airlines or schedules, we suggest that you book your own airfare and take advantage of our "Land Only" options.

Walking: Our trips require daily walking, sometimes up or down slopes, steps, and uneven terrain. We recommend preparing oneself, by walking before the trip. Anyone needing assistance is required to be accompanied by a qualified and physically-able travel companion. We are not responsible for any medical condition that occurs prior, during, or after the trip.

Important information regarding your trip:

Group Air:

Select International Tours is a tour company that specializes in group travel. A group is ten or more people traveling together. For each group we negotiate and secure group air contracts with all major airlines departing from the designated airport. This enables us to keep all passengers within a group traveling together, in most cases utilizing best air rates.

Group air contracts differ from individually purchased airline tickets in many ways. When group air contracts are negotiated, we deposit a certain number of seats to hold the space and GTD the rate. Unused seats must be released at least 90 days prior to departure to avoid a \$ 100.00 per unused seat penalty.

It is important to receive your registration by the deadline stated on the flyer. Once the seats are released back to the airlines, we may be able to accommodate passengers at a different air rate or on a different airline.

Group air contracts limit types of deviations allowed and in some cases issuing tickets at individual rates may be necessary. Individual rates & reservations are not GTD until the tickets are issued. In order to issue an individual ticket we must receive full payment. Taxes and fuel costs are subject to change until the tickets are issued.

Domestic add-on tickets:

We can assist you with domestic air to connect with our international group air if you wish. Indicate on the registration form which airport you wish us to research air from. We are not responsible for fees or charges incurred in case dates change or the trip is cancelled. However, when buying a domestic add-on ticket through Select we may be able to assist in case of changes.

We will provide you with best schedule to connect with the flight (we are not able to help you with tickets that do not connect directly to the international flight) and the best price we can offer. Our information will be sent to you by e-mail. We require an acceptance within 24 hours of our offer along with full payment otherwise the rate is subject to change based on availability. We cannot quote any domestic air requests more than twice.

Business Class and Economy Plus Seats:

We are happy to assist you with business class and economy plus seats. Passengers must be registered on one of our trips to receive a quote. We will quote the available rate which is subject to change until we receive payment to purchase the seats. Usually Economy Plus Seats require the group tickets to be issued before the ability to upgrade.

Passport and Visa information:

All airlines require us to submit valid passport information including full name (first, middle and last), date of birth, gender, country, in which your passport has been issued and passport expiration date. To ensure that we can provide this information accurately, we require a photo copy of each person's passport traveling on each tour. Your passport must be valid 6 months from the trip return date. It is the passenger's responsibility to check if visas are required for the destinations visited and to obtain any necessary travel documents. Select International Tours does not provide information or assistance about passports or visa requirements.

Frequent Flyer Numbers:

Select International cannot assist if you wish to reserve air using FF miles. We can update your record with Frequent Flyer #'s only if you note the number on the registration form. Otherwise please call the airline directly.

Seat Requests & Seat Changes

Select International Tours DOES NOT provide assistance with passenger's seating

preferences or specific seat requests. Due to the large number of passengers we work with, we are unable to provide this service unless the request is due to a medical issue. In this case, we will request a seat with the airline but cannot guarantee that the seat will be confirmed. Please understand that although requests are being made directly with the airline, not every request is guaranteed or granted by the airline. If you would like to have a seat number assigned, it is best to contact the airline directly upon receipt of your ticket confirmation # or change your seats at the time of check-in at the airport prior to departure.

"Land Only" (not purchasing group air with Select International Tour Package:

We understand that some passengers may wish to purchase their own air transportation. Arranging transportation on your own may give you the ability to use flight miles for your ticket, secure the seat you desire/require, or deviate from the group. We offer land only prices on all our tours.

Airport transfers are not provided for passengers purchasing land only (not purchasing air with us) if arriving or departing at any time different from the group. If you wish to enjoy the benefit of the group transfer, please be sure you are at the airport at the same time as the group. On certain itineraries airport transfers, may be very costly as the group may be traveling a far distance from the airport on the first or last day.

If the flight schedule you purchase arrives or departs at a time different from the group, it is your responsibility to join the group either at the airport or at the first hotel.

If you register for the air and land package and convert to land only, a \$ 100.00 service charge will be assessed should the change be made within 90 days of departure.

Flight cancellations or delays:

In case your flight is cancelled or delayed please work with the airline directly at the airport to be rebooked on the first available flight out. Once you know your new flight and time of arrival contact the emergency number provided in your travel documents to notify your guide of the delay. Your travel documents will contain an emergency number and the guide's phone. Any incurred costs are out of pocket and not included in the trip cost. The cost of private transfers in case of delays are not covered as part of your trip cost. You may file a claim with your Travel Protection Insurance company or with the airlines upon your return. Receipts will be required.

Single rooms:

A limited number of single rooms are available on each trip. If you wish to share a room let us know at the time of registration. We will attempt to connect you with another person looking to share. The cost of Travel Protection insurance will be adjusted to reflect the single supplement as insurance cost depends on total trip cost. Should we not be able to accommodate all single room requests and you are not able or willing to share, a complete refund will be provided.

If your roommate cancels, and the room is converted into single usage, a single supplement will be charged.

How much walking will there be on this trip?

This active program covers a good amount of ground each day. The days are busy, usually starting with a wake -up call around 7AM and departure by 9AM or earlier. We aim to be back at the hotel between 5PM and 6PM. Times may vary depending on destination and program.

Expect from three to four hours walking on some touring days. The pace is moderate, however you will encounter some uneven surfaces, stairs, steps, cobblestones, and significant slopes. Some tours require walking in the open air with no shade and no seating available.
