OPTIONAL PRE-TOUR: HIGHLIGHTS OF SWITZERLAND

✚ Saturday, May 20, Day 1: DEPART USA

We depart on an overnight flight to Zurich. Dinner and breakfast will be served on the plane during the international flight. Business-class and premium economy upgrades and add-on airfare is available from most major cities upon request.

✚ Sunday, May 21, Day 2: ZURICH – LUCERNE

Upon arrival we meet our English Speaking tour guide and board the motorcoach for a drive to Lucerne considered one of the most beautiful cities in Switzerland. En route, we stop at Muri Abbey to visit and celebrate Mass. After lunch, we stop in Solothurn to visit Saint Ursus Cathedral. Settle into our hotel in Lucerne for dinner and overnight. (D)

✚ Monday, May 22, Day 3: LUCERNE – MT. TITLIS

We depart by motorcoach to Engelberg Abbey and then by cable car to the top of Mount Titlis, considered one of Switzerland's top destinations. Mass is celebrated at Engelberg Abbey and we have time to explore the lovely little Swiss town. We return to Lucerne for a walking city tour. Tonight we enjoy a typical Swiss dinner with a show in a local restaurant. Overnight in Lucerne. (B. Special dinner)

✚ Tuesday, May 23, Day 4: LUCERNE – JUNGFRAUJOCH

Discover Europe's highest train station on this full-day train tour to Jungfrauoch. We admire the Bernese Oberland on our way to Lauterbrunnen, where we complete our Alpine ascent by cogwheel train. On arrival, we take time to marvel at the UNESCO-listed landscape and explore summit attractions, such as the Ice Palace and Sphinx Observatory where we can soak up the panoramic views over Aletsch Glacier, Europe's longest glacier. Mass will be celebrated. Return to Lucerne for dinner at leisure. (B.)

✚ Wednesday, May 24, Day 5: LUCERNE – ZURICH:

After breakfast at the hotel we take the scenic Gotthard Panorama Express boat on Lake Lucerne before we transfer to Zurich to meet up with the rest of our group and join the participants of the Shrines of Switzerland and the Rhine River Cruise pilgrimage.

MAIN TOUR: SHRINES OF SWITZERLAND AND THE RHINE RIVER CRUISE

✚ Tuesday, May 23, Day 1: DEPART USA

Depart from NYC area airport on an overnight flight to Zurich. Dinner and breakfast will be served on the plane during the international flight. Business-class and premium economy upgrades and add-on airfare is available from most major cities upon request.

✚ Wednesday, May 24, Day 2: ZURICH

We arrive in Zurich this morning and are greeted by our guides. Board the motorcoaches for a drive into the city where we celebrate Mass. We have a city tour and a boat ride down the Limmat River under the bridges. Visit the Fraumunster Church to see the incredible Chagall stained glass windows. Our welcome dinner is at the hotel tonight. Overnight Zurich area. (Welcome dinner)

✚ Thursday, May 25, Day 3: ZURICH – RAPPERSWIL – ST. GALLEN

After breakfast, which is included each morning, we board the motorcoach for a full-day excursion to visit Rapperswil, a Medieval Town where we can stroll along the restored wooden walkway by Lake Zurich, part of the pilgrimage route of the Camino to Santiago de Compostela. After lunch on our own, we visit St. Gallen Abbey and Library, the oldest in Europe a UNESCO, World Heritage Site. Mass will be celebrated. We return to Zurich for dinner at leisure with an opportunity to try the local bratwurst with beer, a favorite food of the locals. Overnight Zurich. (B)

✚ Friday, May 26, Day 4: SWITZERLAND – EINSIEDELN MARIAN SHRINE – BASEL – EMBARKATION FOR THE RHINE RIVER CRUISE

We travel through Switzerland to the Einsiedeln Marian Shrine. Explore the magnificent Monastery with its elaborately decorated pastel ceilings, marble side altars, and a large high altar. The most important part of the Basilica is the Lady Chapel, which is reminiscent of Christ's tomb in Jerusalem's Church of the Holy Sepulcher. Above the chapel's altar is the Black Madonna, resplendent in rich robes and surrounded by gold clouds. We visit the Monastery and celebrate Mass here. Following lunch at leisure, we drive to Basel to embark on our privately chartered river cruise on the beautiful Amadeus Queen ship. After tea and sandwiches, settle into our cabins. The ship sails at 5:00 PM. Enjoy a welcome drink and orientation meeting in the lounge before dinner. Overnight on the cruise. (B.D.)

✚ Saturday, May 27, Day 5: FRANCE – STRASBOURG

This morning, we arrive in the dynamic capital of Alsace. Following breakfast, we board our coaches for a short drive to the city. This ancient city's sights include the famous Strasbourg Münster and the Petite France Quarter, a former mill and tanner district that still maintains its medieval charm. We visit the beautiful Cathedral of Our Lady, which is home to the world's first documented Christmas Tree. The city of Strasbourg is the self-described 'Capital City of Christmas,' as the Strasbourg Christmas Market is the oldest and largest

in France. Following a boat ride on the city canals, enjoy lunch on our own in Strasbourg. We meet at the Cathedral to celebrate Mass before returning to the ship. Enjoy dinner, followed by music in the ship's lounge. Overnight on the cruise. (B.D.)

✚ Sunday, May 28, Day 6: GERMANY – SPEYER – HEIDELBERG – MANNHEIM

We visit the Speyer Cathedral, the burial place of German kings before we board the bus for a tour, including a visit to the beautiful Maulbronn Abbey, which is now a UNESCO Heritage Site. The 850-year-old Romanesque monastery complex, surrounded by turreted walls and a tower gate, is one of the best-preserved examples of its kind in Europe. Following our tour, we move on to Heidelberg, a romantic city considered one of the most beautiful in Germany, nestled between the Neckar river and the foothills of the Odenwald forest. We celebrate Mass in the magnificent Jesuitenkirche, built-in 1712 by the Jesuits. In the afternoon, enjoy exploring Heidelberg's key sites, including the majestic castle, bridges, and scenic "Philosopher's Walk." Lunch is on our own. Return to the ship for dinner and overnight. (B.D.)

✚ Monday, May 29, Day 7: GERMANY – RÜDESHEIM – ST. HILDEGARD – KOBLENZ – SCHOENSTATT MOVEMENT

After breakfast, we visit the Benedictine Abbey of St. Hildegard, where we enjoy a guided tour, celebrate Mass, and visit the shrine of St. Hildegard of Bingen. Hildegard was called "a light for her peoples and her time" by Pope John Paul II and was later made a Doctor of the Church by Pope Benedict in 2012. The Abbey, located on a hill above Rudesheim, has a magnificent view of the Middle Rhine Valley. Set amidst scenic vineyards, the Abbey is home to a community of nuns who continue to live by the rules of Saint Benedict, dedicating themselves to prayer and work. You may choose to walk from the town to the Abbey or take the bus. Rudesheim am Rhein is one of Germany's most prolific and scenic wine regions. It offers beautiful hikes through its mountains and prime views over the dazzling Rhine river valley. Explore this lovely city on your own before we return to the ship for lunch. After lunch, enjoy the magnificent scenery as we travel to Koblenz. Upon disembarkation, we board our buses to travel to the nearby village of Schoenstatt Vallendar, the town that belongs to Our Lady. We visit the Original Shrine that gave origin to the Schoenstatt Movement and the Church of the Most Holy Trinity (Adoration Church) with the tomb of Father Kentenich nearby. We then drive a short distance to the 2000-year-old city of Koblenz, ideally situated at the confluence of the Rhine and the Moselle rivers. Koblenz is a

small, walkable city where we may wish to explore St. Castor Basilica, the Church of Our Beloved Lady, and other major sites on our own. Dinner and overnight are on the ship. (B.L.D.)

✚ Tuesday, May 30, Day 8: GERMANY – MORNING RETREAT – WINE TASTING – COCHEM

This morning, our host Dr. Marcellino D'Ambrosio will lead a retreat on the ship. Following our retreat, we enjoy lunch, taking in the scenery as we sail down the Rhine. We disembark in Cochem, where we celebrate Mass at the Church of St. Martin Cochem. Before returning to our ship, we stop at a local winery for a wine tasting. Dinner and overnight on the ship. (B.L.D.)

✚ Wednesday, May 31, Day 9: GERMANY – COLOGNE – ST. EDITH STEIN

Early this morning, we arrive in Cologne, a 2000-year-old city, spanning the Rhine River and the region's cultural hub. Here, we have a guided tour of the Cathedral and Treasury. The immense Cathedral is the most visited tourist attraction in Germany. Amazingly, although much of the city was destroyed around it during World War II, and the Cathedral itself was hit by fourteen bombs, it emerged mostly unscathed. St. Edith Stein studied Catholicism in Cologne and converted on Jan 1, 1922, at St. Martin's Church. She was beatified on May 1, 1987, in Cologne, by Pope St John Paul II, and canonized by him in 1998 at St. Peter's Basilica in Rome. We hear the story of St. Teresa Benedicta of the Cross and her journey as she left Cologne for Echt, Holland. We also see the Church of St. Andrew and the tomb of St. Albertus Magnus. We celebrate Mass and have time at leisure to explore Cologne. Tonight, we enjoy the Captain's Gala Dinner and entertainment aboard the ship. Overnight on the ship. (B.L.D.)

✚ Thursday, June 1, Day 10: HOLLAND – AMSTERDAM

Enjoy watching the beautiful scenery as we sail into Holland. This morning we drive to the Shrine of Our Lady of All Nations for Mass and a visit. In the afternoon return to Amsterdam for an afternoon at leisure to explore the city on our own or visit a local museum. We may return to the ship for lunch or stay in the city of Amsterdam and have lunch on our own*. Dinner and overnight on the ship. (B.L.D.)*

✚ Friday, June 2, Day 11: AMSTERDAM DISEMBARKATION – RETURN TO USA

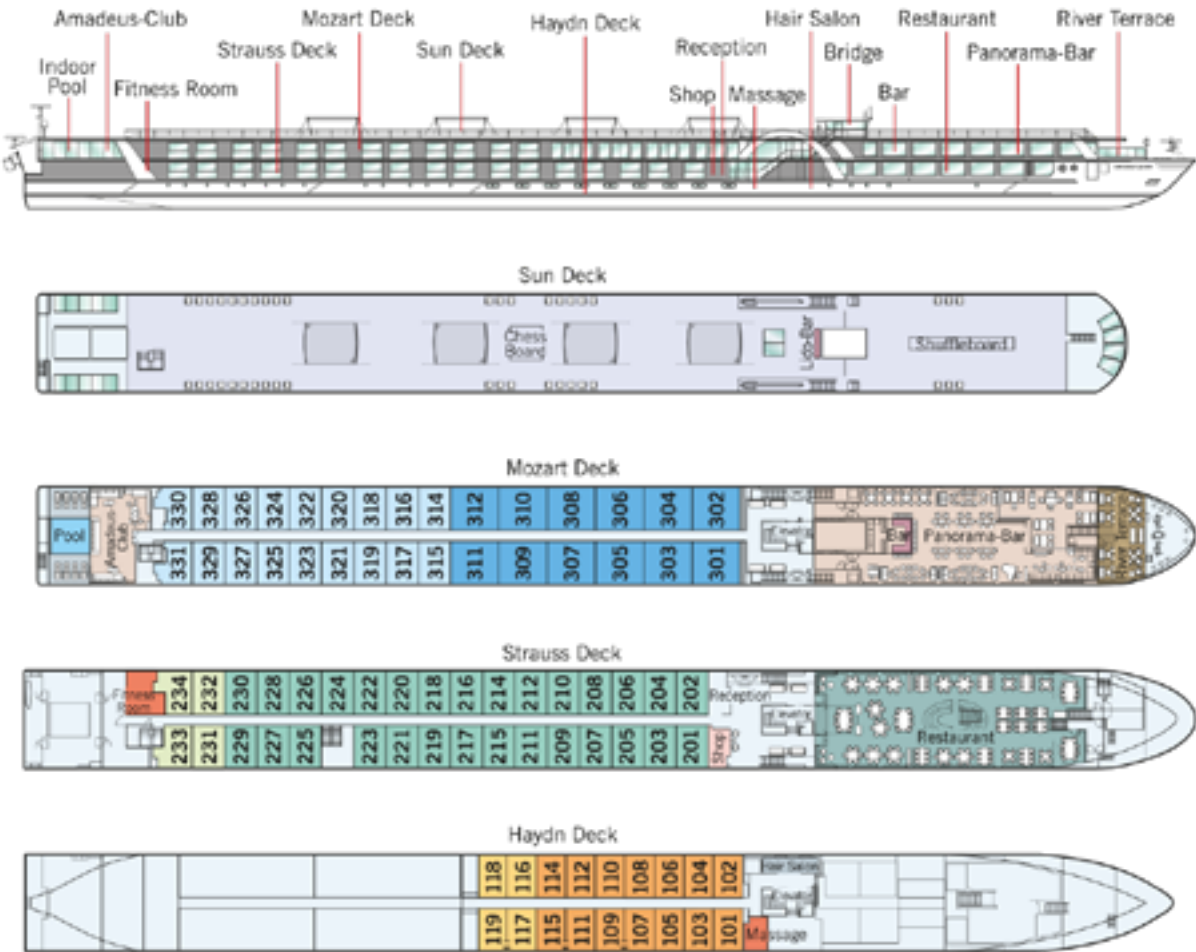
Early this morning we are transferred to the airport for our flight home. (B.)



The Amadeus Queen sails along on the Danube, Rhine, and Main. It can also be found cruising the Dutch and Belgian Waterways. Similar to its prominent predecessors, this ship continues our orientation to high-quality river cruises in Europe. This beautiful vessel follows the award-winning model of the AMADEUS Silver ships but offers even further innovative developments. The popular concept of spaciousness has been maintained. This includes not only generous public areas but also spacious cabins: 12 large suites impress with an outdoor balcony, and a cozy reading corner whilst the 69 standard cabins mainly have panoramic window fronts which can be automatically lowered and luxurious bathrooms. A new on-board highlight is the indoor pool, the roof of which can be opened in fine weather. In the evenings, this area may also be used for informative talks and functions. The ship's exclusive "River Terrace" open-air lounge is in the bow, and its specially designed glazing provides an incomparable view of the passing riverside scenery while simultaneously providing protection against wind and rain.

Rules and Regulations

Deposits and Final Payment: This is an exclusive by invitation-only, pilgrimage hosted by Dr. Marcellino D'Ambrosio, who reserves the right to approve all requests to participate in the tour. A non-refundable **deposit of \$1,000.00** per person by check should accompany the registration form along with your optional travel protection payment, and a copy of your passport picture page by **January 10, 2023. Final payment is due by February 22, 2023. A late payment fee of \$100 will be charged per person for all payments received after the final payment date. Please mail your payment made payable to Select International Tours to: Lisa Morris, 4209 Whitlow Ave., Knoxville, TN 37919. Your passport must be valid through January 26, 2024. Reservations will not be processed until we have passport copies. Your passport must be valid through December 2, 2023. Reservations will not be processed until we have passport copies.** Prices quoted are based on cash payments. See pricing table on page two for cash prices and credit card prices.

Solo Travel: A limited number of single rooms are available. Prices are based on two people per room. We do not guarantee room mates but will do our best to connect you with a possible share.

Land Only Option: Land only services start and end at the hotels, unless you are able to meet the group at the airport, and do not include airfare.

Pilgrimage Prices: Prices are based on minimum 120 passengers. Prices may be adjusted in the event of fewer than 120 passengers, changes in currency conversion rates, or amendments in local government taxes and/or fuel surcharges. Prices are in US dollars. For European travel an exchange rate of US \$1.16 per Euro is assumed.

Tour Cancellation Policy: Individual deposits are refundable except for 750.00 per person up to 120 days prior to departure. From 120- 90 days prior to departure \$ 1000.00 is non-refundable. Within 90 days, all payments are non-refundable. Unused portions of the trip are non-refundable. All airline tickets are non-refundable once issued. All cancellations must be in writing. Unused portions of the trip are not refundable. We strongly encourage you to purchase **Travel Protection**. Call or visit our website for details on the cost per person for the Group Deluxe and Cancel For Any Reason (CFAR) plans. CFAR is not available in N.Y. State. Airline Seating and Special Requests: To best accommodate our pil-

grims, we often utilize Group Air Reservations. These allow more predictable transfer and tour schedules. However, when booking Group Air, the airline (not Select International Tours) controls seating assignments. If you require very specific seats, we suggest that you book your own airfare and take advantage of our "Land Only" options. You may communicate directly with the airline to request seating changes, provide mileage program information, or change passenger contact information once you receive ticket numbers—approximately three (3) weeks prior to departure. We work with instant purchase airline tickets and or group rates. If you switch from air and land to land only within 90 days from departure you will be charged a \$100 service fee in addition to any airline charges. All special needs and requests due to medical or dietary restrictions must be requested in writing at least 60 days prior to departure. Business class and Premium Coach seats are available upon written request; as are add-ons from your hometown airport. If you require very specific airlines or schedules, we suggest that you book your own airfare and take advantage of our "Land Only" options.

Walking: Our trips require daily walking, sometimes up or down slopes, steps, and uneven terrain. We recommend preparing oneself, by walking before the trip. Anyone needing assistance is required to be accompanied by a qualified and physically-able travel companion. We are not responsible for any medical condition that occurs prior, during, or after the trip.

Important information regarding your trip:

Group Air:

Select International Tours is a tour company that specializes in group travel. A group is ten or more people traveling together. For each group we negotiate and secure group air contracts with all major airlines departing from the designated airport. This enables us to keep all passengers within a group traveling together, in most cases utilizing best air rates.

Group air contracts differ from individually purchased airline tickets in many ways. When group air contracts are negotiated, we deposit a certain number of seats to hold the space and GTD the rate. Unused seats must be released at least 90 days prior to departure to avoid a \$ 100.00 per unused seat penalty.

It is important to receive your registration by the deadline stated on the flyer. Once the seats are released back to the airlines, we may be able to accommodate passengers at a different air rate or on a different airline.

Group air contracts limit types of deviations allowed and in some cases issuing tickets at individual rates may be necessary. Individual rates & reservations are not GTD until the tickets are issued. In order to issue an individual ticket we must receive full payment. Taxes and fuel costs are subject to change until the tickets are issued.

Domestic add-on tickets:

We can assist you with domestic air to connect with our international group air if you wish. Indicate on the registration form which airport you wish us to research air from. We are not responsible for fees or charges incurred in case dates change or the trip is cancelled. However, when buying a domestic add-on ticket through Select we may be able to assist in case of changes.

We will provide you with best schedule to connect with the flight (we are not able to help you with tickets that do not connect directly to the international flight) and the best price we can offer. Our information will be sent to you by e-mail. We require an acceptance within 24 hours of our offer along with full payment otherwise the rate is subject to change based on availability. We cannot quote any domestic air requests more than twice.

Business Class and Economy Plus Seats:

We are happy to assist you with business class and economy plus seats. Passengers must be registered on one of our trips to receive a quote. We will quote the available rate which is subject to change until we receive payment to purchase the seats. Usually Economy Plus Seats require the group tickets to be issued before the ability to upgrade.

Passport and Visa information:

All airlines require us to submit valid passport information including full name (first, middle and last), date of birth, gender, country, in which your passport has been issued and passport expiration date. To ensure that we can provide this information accurately, we require a photo copy of each person's passport traveling on each tour. Your passport must be valid 6 months from the trip return date. It is the passenger's responsibility to check if visas are required for the destinations visited and to obtain any necessary travel documents. Select International Tours does not provide information or assistance about passports or visa requirements.

Frequent Flyer Numbers:

Select International cannot assist if you wish to reserve air using FF miles. We can update your record with Frequent Flyer #'s only if you note the number on the registration form. Otherwise please call the airline directly.

Seat Requests & Seat Changes

Select International Tours DOES NOT provide assistance with passenger's seating preferences or specific seat requests. Due to the large number of passengers we work with, we are unable to provide this service unless the request is due to a medical issue. In this case, we will request a seat with the airline but cannot guarantee that the seat will be confirmed. Please understand that although requests are being made directly with the airline, not every request is guaranteed or granted by the airline. If you would like to have a seat number assigned, it is best to contact the airline directly upon receipt of your ticket confirmation # or change your seats at the time of check-in at the airport prior to departure.

“Land Only” (not purchasing group air with Select International Tour Package:

We understand that some passengers may wish to purchase their own air transportation. Arranging transportation on your own may give you the ability to use flight miles for your ticket, secure the seat you desire/require, or deviate from the group. We offer land only prices on all our tours.

Airport transfers are not provided for passengers purchasing land only (not purchasing air with us) if arriving or departing at any time different from the group. If you wish to enjoy the benefit of the group transfer, please be sure you are at the airport at the same time as the group. On certain itineraries airport transfers, may be very costly as the group may be traveling a far distance from the airport on the first or last day.

If the flight schedule you purchase arrives or departs at a time different from the group, it is your responsibility to join the group either at the airport or at the first hotel.

If you register for the air and land package and convert to land only, a \$ 100.00 service charge will be assessed should the change be made within 90 days of departure.

Flight cancellations or delays:

In case your flight is cancelled or delayed please work with the airline directly at the airport to be rebooked on the first available flight out. Once you know your new flight and time of arrival contact the emergency number provided in your travel documents to notify your guide of the delay. Your travel documents will contain an emergency number and the guide's phone. Any incurred costs are out of pocket and not included in the trip cost. The cost of private transfers in case of delays are not covered as part of your trip cost. You may file a claim with your Travel Protection Insurance company or with the airlines upon your return. Receipts will be required.

Single rooms:

A limited number of single rooms are available on each trip. If you wish to share a room let us know at the time of registration. We will attempt to connect you with another person looking to share. The cost of Travel Protection insurance will be adjusted to reflect the single supplement as insurance cost depends on total trip cost. Should we not be able to accommodate all single room requests and you are not able or willing to share, a complete refund will be provided.

If your roommate cancels, and the room is converted into single usage, a single supplement will be charged.

How much walking will there be on this trip?

This active program covers a good amount of ground each day. The days are busy, usually starting with a wake-up call around 7AM and departure by 9AM or earlier. We aim to be back at the hotel between 5PM and 6PM. Times may vary depending on destination and program.

Expect from three to four hours walking on some touring days. The pace is moderate, however you will encounter some uneven surfaces, stairs, steps, cobblestones, and significant slopes. Some tours require walking in the open air with no shade and no seating available.
