



Monday, May 18, Day 1: LONDON ARRIVAL

Arrive at your hotel and check in (after 4 PM). You may want to visit Westminster Abbey for 5 PM Evensong. This is where most British kings and queens since 1066 have been crowned. It's the final resting place for many monarchs, heroes, authors, and poets. This is also where 151 theologians met in the 1640s to draw up the Westminster Confession of Faith, which is the standard of doctrine for the Church of Scotland and many Presbyterian churches worldwide. At 6:30 PM, we meet in the hotel lobby for our welcome group dinner. Overnight in London. (D)

Tuesday, May 19, Day 2: ELY CATHEDRAL AND CAMBRIDGE

Departing London, we first visit Ely Cathedral, in Cambridgeshire, before arriving in Cambridge, a center of Protestant scholarship for leaders including Archbishop Thomas Cranmer, and Bishops Nicholas Ridley and Hugh Latimer. We visit the Round House in Cambridge and enjoy the Reformation-themed walk, during which we see Latimer's pulpit in the church of St. Edward the King and Martyr. We also view the plague showing the site of the White Horse Inn, St. Mary the Great, and Christ's College, Emmanuel College. This evening we dine in a local restaurant. Overnight in Cambridge. (B. Special dinner)

Wednesday, May 20, Day 3; DURHAM

This morning, we depart for Durham, voted "Best City in the UK" by Condé Nast Traveler magazine readers. Durham Cathedral is a UNES-CO World Heritage site and regarded as the finest Norman building in Europe. We tour the Cathedral (must be before 3 PM) and attend the Evensong (TBC). This evening, dinner is at the medieval Prior's Hall, originally the Prior's Dining Room when the Cathedral was a Benedictine Monastery. We spend the night in Durham. (B. Special dinner)

Thursday, May 21, Day 4: THE HOLY ISLAND OF LINDISFARNE

We depart for Lindisfarne, known as the Holy Island. The tidal island is located off the Northumbrian coast. The Holy Island is accessible by causeway, so our visit time will be dictated by the tide schedule. St. Aidan was sent here as a missionary from Iona, in Scotland, and established a monastery around 630 AD. When the Vikings destroyed the original monastery, the monks fled from the island. The present Lindisfarne Priory is a dramatic ruin, modeled after Durham Cathedral. This is where the famous Lindisfarne Gospels were produced. Even secular historians refer to Lindisfarne as "the most holy place in England." After a visit to the island, we settle into our hotel in the area for dinner and overnight. (B.D)

Friday, May 22, Day 5: YORK

Drive to York to visit Rievaulx Abbey, located in the tranquil countryside, where we see the impressive ruins of a once very powerful Cistercian Monastery. Following time for a coffee break and a visit to the museum, we drive to York, where we meet our local guide who takes us on a visit to the Medieval "Shambles." We tour the York Minster, the biggest medieval church in England, with an impressive collection of medieval stained glass, including a sixteenth-century rose window. The term "Minster" usually refers to a church in a monastery, but this cathedral was never part of a monastic institution, so it doesn't have cloisters. Christianity has an early heritage in York. By 306, when Constantine the Great was proclaimed Emperor in York, York had a small Christian community. In 312, he issued a general edict of toleration for the Christian Church and York became a center of Christianity. The rest of the day is at leisure to attend Evensong, shop or relax. Overnight in York. (B)



Saturday, May 23, Day 6: BRISTOL

We depart for Bristol and visit the New Room, the oldest Methodist Chapel in the World. George Whitefield invited John Wesley to come to Bristol in 1729, and he began his ministry with open-air preaching. He purchased the land to build the New Room in 1742. We visit the Museum, which tells the story of the early beginnings of Methodism. We also visit the home where John's younger brother lived with his family. Charles Wesley was a prolific hymn writer and also preached. Time permitting, we visit St. Mary Redcliffe Church, considered the most beautiful Gothic Church in all of England. Dinner and overnight in Bristol. (B.D)

Sunday, May 24, Day 7: SALISBURY - BRISTOL - SARUM COLLEGE

This morning, we enjoy a visit to Bristol, followed by a lovely drive to

Salisbury Cathedral to attend the beautiful Evensong service at 4:30 PM (TBC). Select International Tours services conclude once we reach Sarum College. (B)




